Subject: REVERSE FENCELINE SPRAY PROGRAM	Control Code: 11.35

Purpose:

To prevent noxious weed infestations in fencelines and headland areas from further spreading in roadside ditches or cropland.

Authority:

Weeds and invasive plants are regulated under the provincial *Weed Control Act*. Under the *Agricultural Service Board Act*, the Agricultural Service Board has the responsibility to advise, organize and direct weed control.

Definitions:

- “Landowner” means any person registered under the Land Titles Act as the owner, or a person who is in lawful possession of the property or who has the right to exercise control over the property.
- “Occupant” means any person occupying or exercising control or having the right to occupy or exercise control over the land.
- “Weed – invasive plant” means plant species designated by the *Weed Control Act* or by a Camrose County by-law as “Prohibited Noxious or Noxious”.

Policy Statements:

1. The landowner or occupant adjacent to a roadside may apply to the Agricultural Service Board to enter their property for the purpose of spraying the fenceline or headland areas in the direction towards the roadside.
2. Control work performed on fencelines and headlands adjacent to County roads will be done on a first come first served basis at no charge to the landowner or occupant.
3. Fencelines and headland areas which are not adjacent to County roads will be subject to a charge of \$75.00 per half of one mile sprayed. A minimum charge of \$75.00 applies.

THEREFORE, _____ agree to indemnify and save harmless the County from any and all losses, costs, damages, actions, causes of action, suits, claims and demands resulting from anything done or omitted to be done by the treatment, control measures applied, performance or purported performance of the said undertakings.

I understand that the chemical application may restrict the growth of certain plants and crops including alfalfa, potatoes, canola, lentils, beans, trees and other for several years. Grasses and cereal grains are not affected.

This Agreement inures to the benefit of and is binding upon the Parties hereto and their respective heirs, successors and approved assigns.
