Subject: RAILWAY WEED CONTROL	Control Code: 11.11

Purpose:

To prevent establishment and spread of prohibited noxious and noxious weeds along railway right-of-ways.

Definitions:

- “railway right-of-way” means a strip of land that is granted, through an easement or other mechanism, for transportation purposes. A right-of-way is reserved for the purposes of maintenance or expansion of existing services with the right-of-way.

Policy Statement:

1. The Agricultural Fieldman is authorized to custom spray weeds along Canadian National Railways, Canadian Pacific Railways and the Battle River Railway Alliance subject to an agreement with the Railroad Company.
2. If possible Camrose County will enter into a mutual agreement with the railway to control weeds along their right of ways. If a mutual agreement cannot be reached, the respective railroad will be issued a weed notice pursuant to guidelines under the *Weed Control Act*.
