POLICY: MOWING

POLICY:

Beaver County will direct the mowing of developed road allowances, subdivisions, and County lands.

DEFINITIONS:

County Lands: All property owned and/or operated by Beaver County.

Developed Road Allowances: Road allowances containing a gravel or hard-surfaced roadway under the jurisdiction of Beaver County.

GUIDELINES:

Beaver County will mow developed road allowances, including roadways within subdivisions, annually to maintain visibility for the travelling public, improve drainage of infrastructure, control weeds and other vegetation encroaching the road surface. Beaver County will mow County lands on an as-needed basis.

1. Beaver County will mow all developed road allowances, west of Secondary Highway 834, at least once annually.
2. Beaver County will mow road allowances, which only contain hard-surfaced roadways, east of Secondary Highway 834, at least once annually.
3. County lands will be cut on an as-needed basis. The determination and scheduling of these mowing activities will be at the discretion of County staff.
4. Mowing requests from the public, for road allowances outside of scheduled operations, must be made directly to the Agricultural Fieldman.
5. Scheduling and completion of mowing requests will be at the discretion of County staff and availability of resources.
