Subject:	SALE OF HERBICIDES	Control Code:	11.08

**Purpose:**

To offer farmers an effective chemical option for use on their lands to control specified weed infestations.

**Definitions:**

- “Specified Weed Infestations” – prohibited noxious weeds as specified in the *Weed Control Act* including weeds identified by the Agricultural Service Board as a concern; Toadflax, Scentless Chamomile, Canada Thistle, Ox Eye Daisy, Common Tansy, Wild Caraway and Leafy Spurge.

**Policy Statement:**

1. The Agricultural Service Board will offer to farmers at one half of cost price Tordon 22K (Picloram).
2. If required, additional in stock herbicides will be sold at one half of cost for weed control.
3. The Agricultural Service Board will not sell pesticides to farmers in competition with local agriculture retailers.
