STUBBLE BURNING - By-law No. 795

- (1) The Council, through its Soil Conservation Officer, may issue a permit for the burning of stubble on land, provided the Applicant for the permit complies with the requirements of the Soil Conservation Officer acting in accordance with the instructions of Council or the Agricultural Service Board for the County of Camrose No. 22.
- (2) The said Soil Conservation Officer may issue a permit for the burning of stubble for a period of time within such period as may be established on the recommendation of the Agricultural Service Board.
- (3) The Council, through its Soil Conservation Officer, may in his discretion, suspend, reinstate or revoke any permit.
- (4) No person shall burn stubble on any land within the County of Camrose No. 22 without first obtaining a permit issued pursuant to this by-law.
- (5) A person who contravenes a provision of this By-law is guilty of an offense and liable to the penalties as set out in the Soil Conservation Act of Alberta.
- (6) By-laws No. 108 and 466 are hereby repealed.

The Agricultural Service Board will advertise the existence of the Stubble Burning By-law at the appropriate time in each year.

N.B. - Permits for the burning of stubble or loose straw, not including bales, without first having worked the land shall only be issued by the Agricultural Fieldman's Office AFTER inspection. Permits will not be approved for overall stubble burning. No permit shall be issued which will expire later than June 1st in any year. Stubble burning permits will be approved based on the merits of each individual application.
