Policy Title Weed Control - Private Land Weed Control	Date: May 9, 2017	Resolution No. 296/17

Purpose:


To establish a policy, that would assist private land owners on agricultural land within Kneehill County in the prevention of prohibited noxious and noxious weed establishment in accordance to Bylaw #1619 as amended, and The Alberta Weed Control Act, being Statutes of Alberta 2008 Chapter W-5.1 and the Alberta Weed Control Regulation (Alberta Regulation 19/2010) as amended.

Policy Statement:

Kneehill County ASB will assist with pesticide applications on agricultural production lands, to control all prohibited noxious weeds and small patches of selected noxious weeds, on a cost recovery basis.

Policy Guidelines/Procedures:

1. Weeds designated for control on all lands within Kneehill County include those designated as Prohibited Noxious and Noxious under the Alberta Weed Control Act.
2. Maximum control area for Noxious weeds will be half a hectare (1 acre) in crop land.
3. Maximum control area for Noxious weeds will be one hectare (3 acres) in non-cropland.
4. A complete reverse fence line pesticide application may be done if requested by the land manager or land owner.
5. All pesticide applications require a permission to enter agreement signed by the person in control of the land.
6. All pesticide applications will be done on a cost recovery basis.
7. All private land pesticide applications require approval from the Agriculture Fieldman.
