

What is CAP?

- The Canadian Agricultural Partnership (CAP) is a fiveyear investment by federal, provincial and territorial governments to strengthen the agriculture, agri-food and agri-based products sector
- In Alberta, CAP will commit to the same level of investment as Growing Forward 2, which is \$406 million, towards Strategic Initiatives programs.
- Outcomes:
 - Increase competitiveness; productivity; profitability;
 - Increase environmental sustainability;
 - Expand domestic and international markets; and
 - Improve the anticipation, mitigation and response to risks.
