



Deer Products – Velvet Antler and Tendons

Velvet antler, together with ginseng and donkey hide gelatin are recognized as three premium treasures in Chinese traditional medicines. It has been used in oriental countries for centuries, mostly as tonic and a remedy for male impotence and female infertility, anemia, arthritis, insomnia, amnesia, etc.

Parkland Processing Inc. has been processing and exporting velvet antler since 1985. Currently, we process and export about 80% of *Cervus elaphus* velvet antlers harvested from stags (mostly less than 6 years of age) raised in registered Canadian and U.S. deer farms. The quantity and a variety of natural feedings, plus plenty of sunlight in the season when antler grows make the quality of our antlers top in the world.

Our state-of-the-art facility is located in Calgary, Alberta. It is registered by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency and the U.S. Food and Drug Administration. We adapt a nature-like processing mechanism that includes freeze-drying and vacuum deep drying to maximize the preservation of the bioactive potential of velvet antler. No chemicals other than potable spirit is used for processing. No preservatives are used.
