

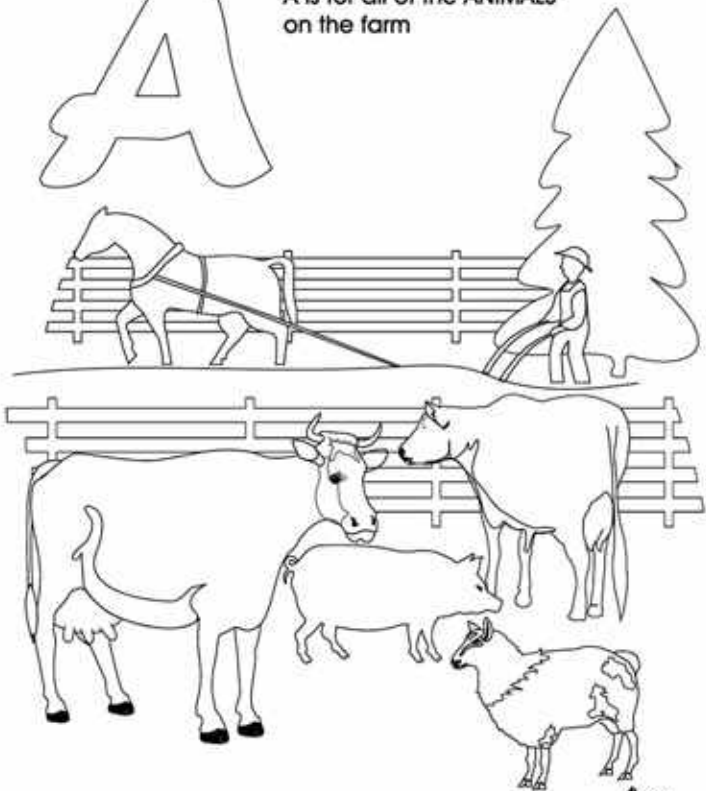

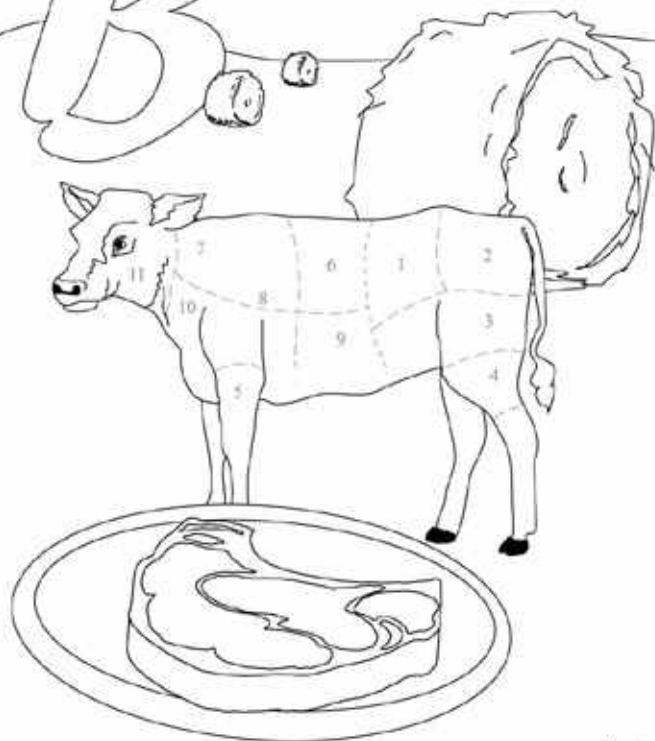

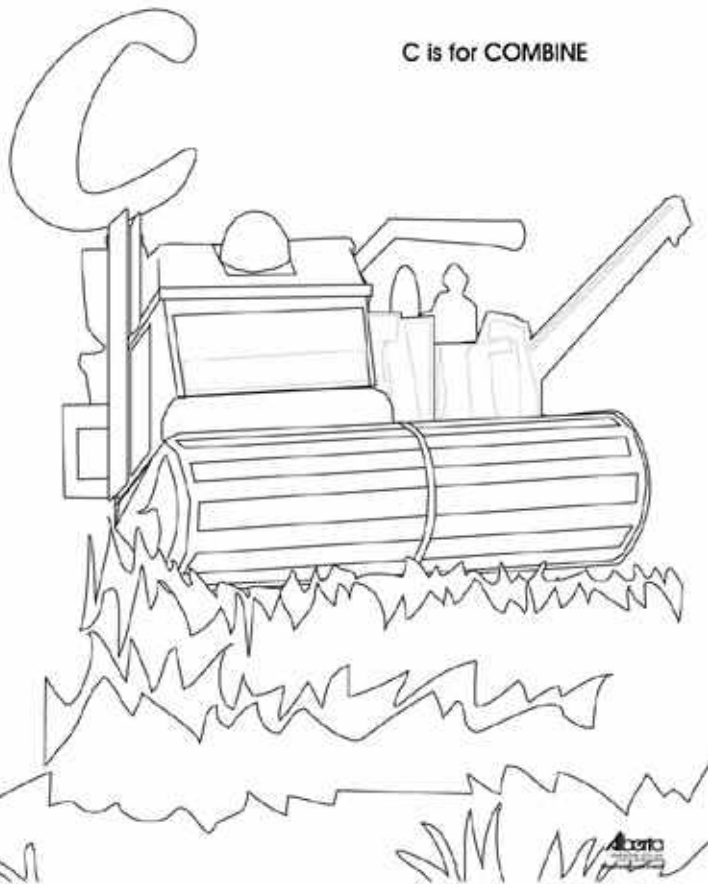
A is for all of the ANIMALS

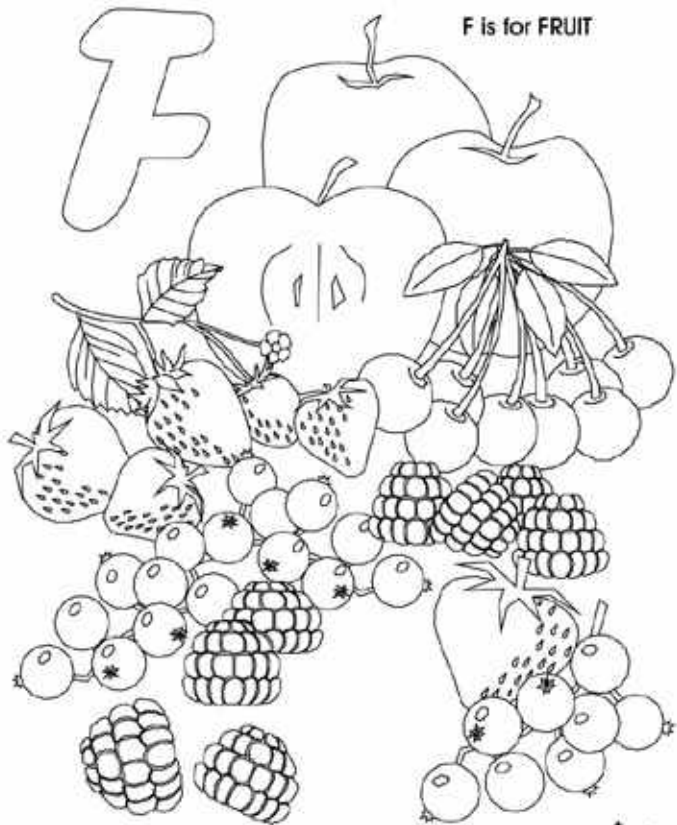

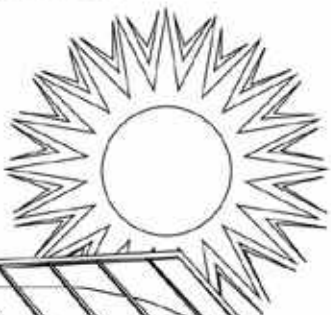


F is for FRUIT

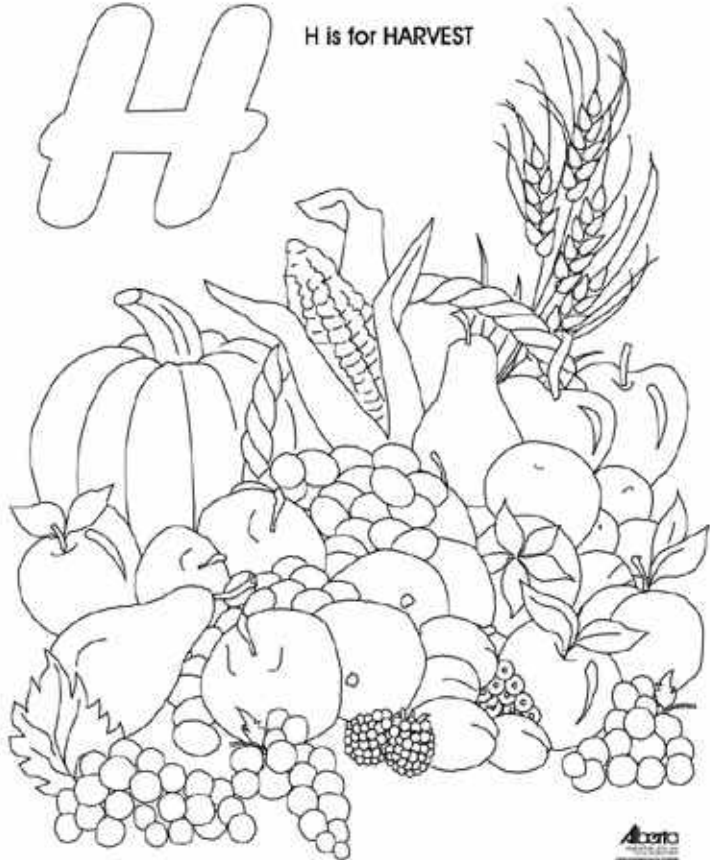

I is for INSECTS. Not all bugs are bad. Many of them are a sign of good health and help control the bad pests



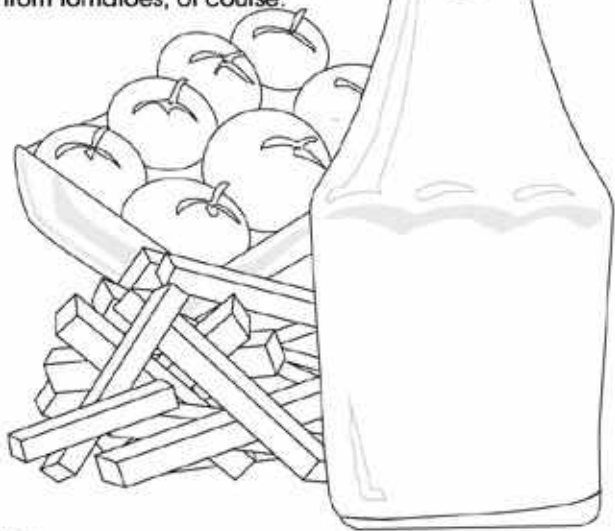

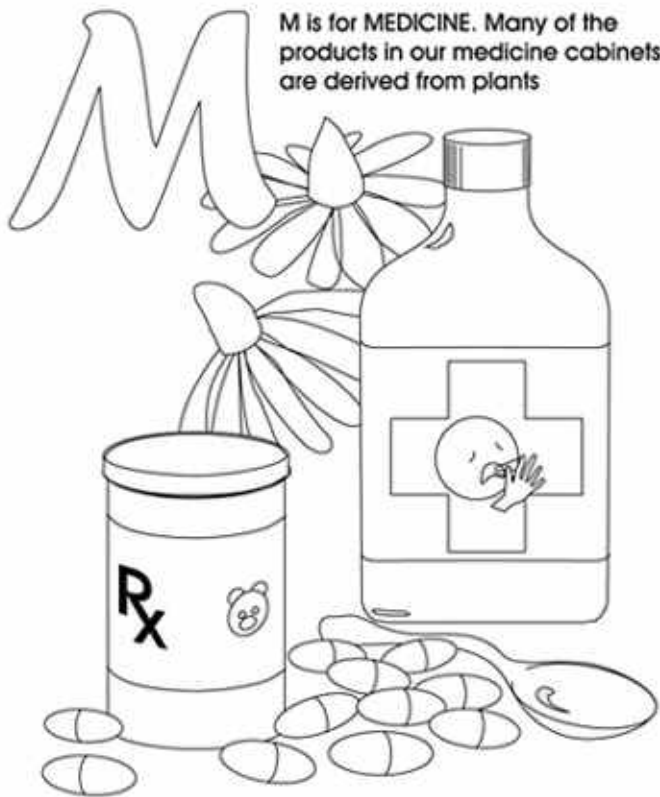
K is for KETCHUP which is made from tomatoes, of course.



L is for LUMBER.

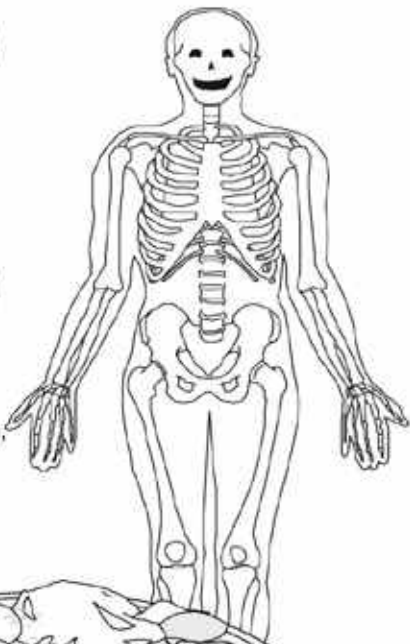


M is for MEDICINE. Many of the products in our medicine cabinets are derived from plants

**N** is for **NUTRIENTS** that make our bones and muscles healthy and strong. We get the nutrients our body needs by eating fresh, healthy foods

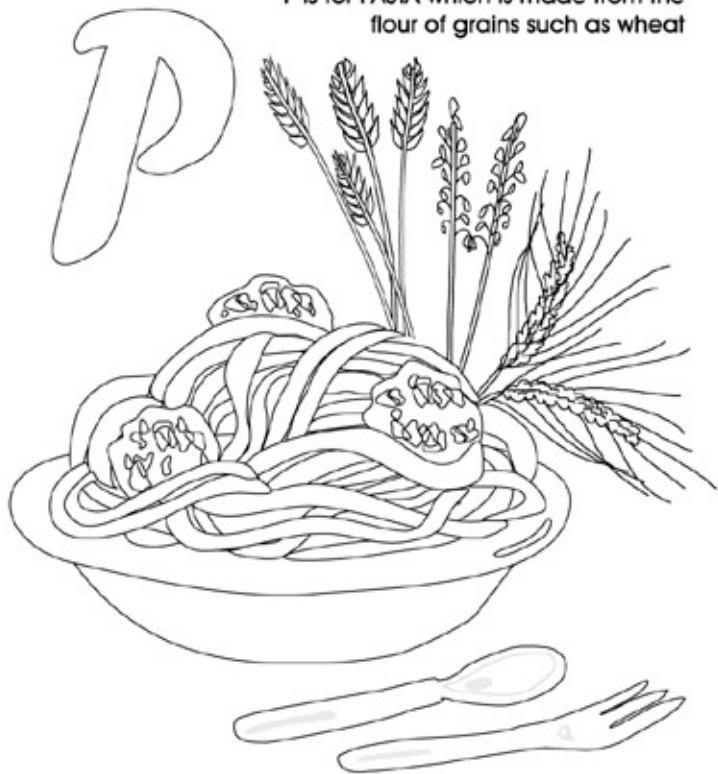


O is for OIL. Most of the Oils used for cooking are derived from the seeds or fruit of flowering plants



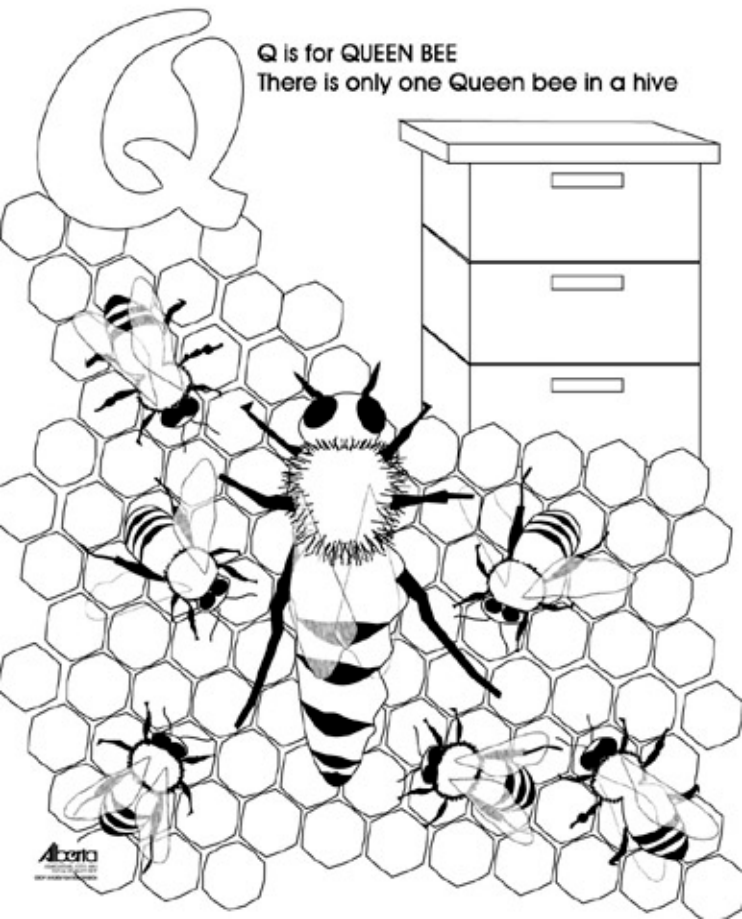


P is for PASTA which is made from the

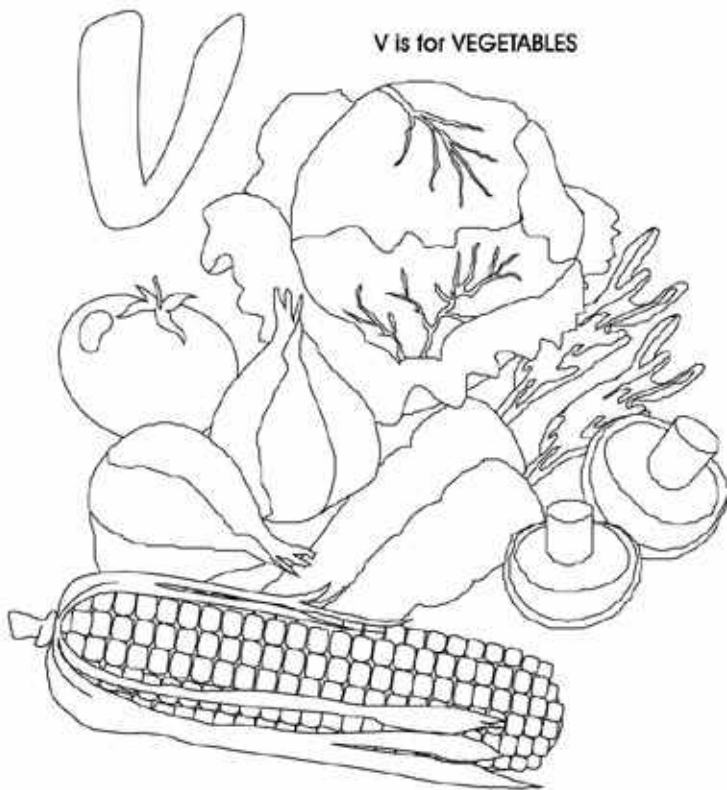
T is for TRACTOR.

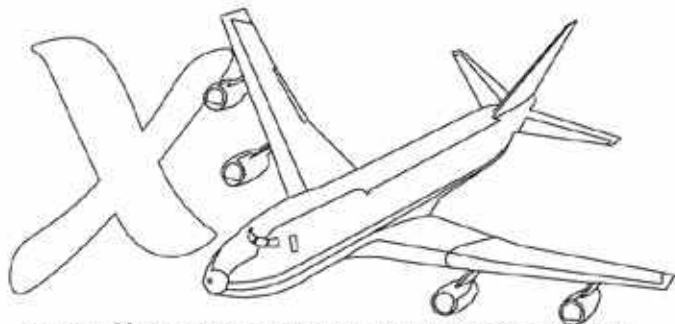

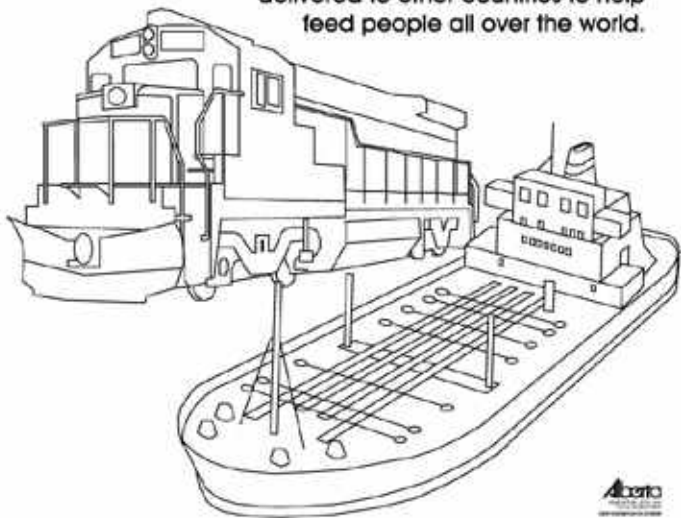
W is for WHEAT. Wheat grains are dried then ground to make flour which is the main ingredient in bread and pasta



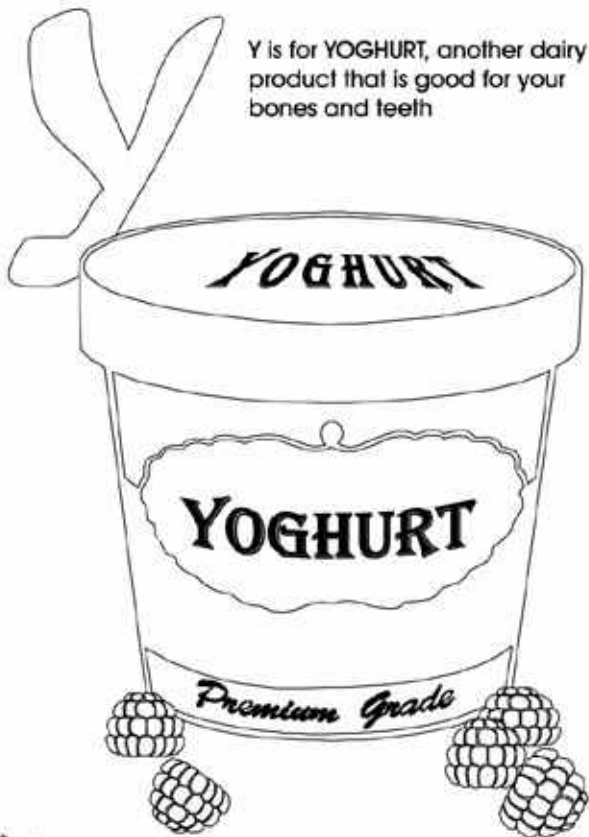




**X is for EXPORTS.** Many of our Agricultural products are delivered to other countries to help feed people all over the world.

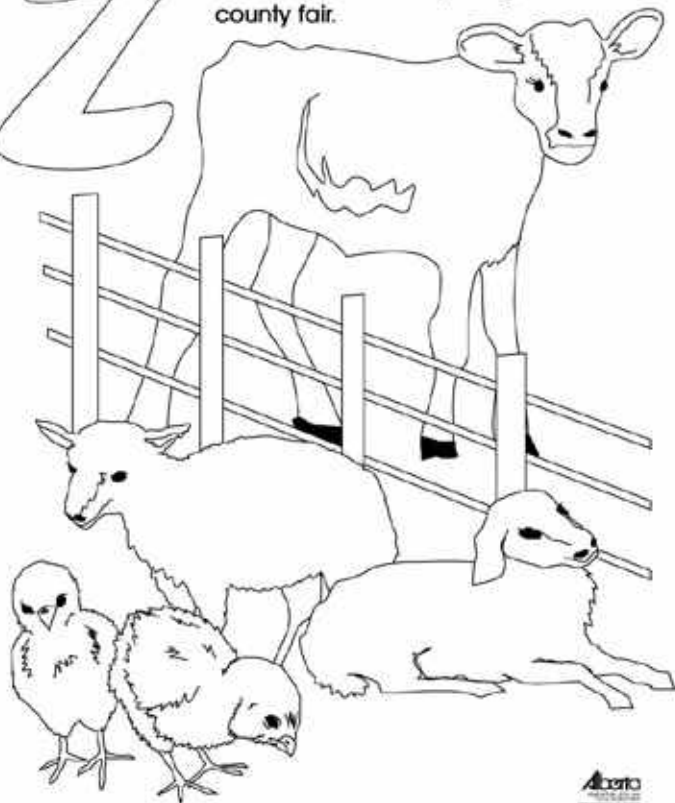


Y is for YOGHURT, another dairy product that is good for your bones and teeth
