POLICY STATEMENT

The Agricultural Service Board will attempt to promote the use of field shelterbelts of either natural or planted trees.

POLICY

The Agricultural Service Board will co-operate with Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada PFRA and the Alberta Shelterbelt program in carrying out their shelterbelt programs. The A.S.B. will work towards keeping sufficient information available for any interested parties. The A.S.B. will act as a distribution agent for trees for the County if requested by the Alberta Shelterbelt Program, Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada PFRA and or other agencies approved by the A.S.B.

The County encourages the landowners to plant the shelterbelt trees seven (7) meters from a statutory road allowance.
