

County of Newell #4
By-law No. 1360-01

A By-law of the County of Newell #4, in the Province of Alberta, to control Common Burdock.

Whereas, Common Burdock is not classified as either a nuisance, noxious or restricted weed under the regulation of the Weed Control Act of Alberta, and there is no way at present that a landowner can be compelled to control this weed when found on his property;

And Whereas, this plant has made its appearance in various areas in the County of Newell #4;

And Whereas, the Agricultural Service Board of the County of Newell #4 is empowered to recommend to Council that certain weeds be relegated to the status of Noxious Weeds;

Therefore, the Council of the County of Newell #4 enacts as follows: that Common Burdock (*Arctium minus*) be designated a Noxious Weed within the County of Newell #4.
