By-law No. 1115-94

A By-law of the County of Newell #4, in the Province of Alberta, to control Downy Brome.

Whereas, Downy Brome is classified as a nuisance weed under the regulation of the Weed Control Act of Alberta, and there is no way at present that a landowner can be compelled to control this weed when found on his property,

And Whereas, this plant has made its appearance in various areas in the County of Newell #4,

And Whereas, the Agricultural Service Board of the County of Newell #4 is empowered to recommend to Council that certain weeds be relegated to the status of Noxious Weeds,

Therefore, the Council of the County of Newell #4 enacts as follows: Downy Brome (*Bromus tectorum* L.) be designated a Noxious Weed within the County of Newell #4.


