By-law #1009-90

A By-law of the County of Newell No. 4, in the Province of Alberta,
to control Narrow-leaved Hawk's-beard

Whereas Narrow-leaved Hawk's-beard is classified as a Nuisance
Weed under the regulations of the Weed Control Act and, as such,
there is no way at present that a landowner can be compelled to
control these plants growing on his property

And Whereas, this weed is rapidly becoming a major problem in
alfalfa fields in the County of Newell No. 4, and the sale of
alfalfa as forage and seed is a viable part of our agricultural
economy


And Whereas the Agricultural Service Board of the County of Newell
No. 4 can request that certain weeds be designated as noxious
weeds within the County of Newell No. 4 and is, in fact, making
such a request in reference to Narrow-leaved Hawk's-beard

Therefore the Council of the County of Newell No. 4 enacts as
follows: that Narrow-leaved Hawk's-beard (*Crepus tectorum* L.)
be designated as a noxious weed within the County of Newell No. 4.

This By-law is to come into force on final date of approval by
the Minister of Agriculture, Province of Alberta.

reading. Carried.
- July 5, 1990 Moved by Councillor Douglass that consent of Council be given
for third and final reading of By-law 1009-90. Carried Unanimously.
- July 5, 1990 Moved by Councillor Nelson that By-law 1009-90 receive third and
final reading. Carried.
