

## Census of Agriculture

Statistics Canada conducts the Census of Agriculture and the Census of Population for Canada every five years. The Alberta statistics presented here are highlights from the latest Census of Agriculture, conducted on May 15, 2001, with comparison statistics from the 1996 Census of Agriculture.

Included is information on primary production, farm numbers, land use, farm operating arrangements, capital and operating expenses. Some additional information on farm operators has not yet been released by Statistics Canada, and will be presented in a supplement to this brochure when it becomes available.

A census farm is an agricultural operation producing at least one of the following products intended for sale: crops (including field crops, tree fruits or nuts, berries or grapes, vegetables, seed); livestock (cattle, hogs, sheep, horses, exotic animals); poultry (hens, chickens, turkeys, exotic birds); animal products (milk, cream, eggs, wool, furs, meats); and other agricultural products (greenhouse or nursery products, Christmas trees, mushrooms, sod, honey and maple syrup).
